

FIRE TRIANGLE & FIRE MANAGEMENT



Spark Catcher – Fibers	hair size, fluff or charred cloth	place in the Bird Nest bowl
Bird Nest – Fibers	hair to fine pencil lead size	form into a two fist ed bowl
Tinder – Twigs	matchstick to pencil size	gently place over Bird Nest
Kindling – Sticks	pencil to broom stick size	gently place on the burning fire
Fuel – Logs	gradually increase the size	feed the burning fire

Remember:

- maintain equal amounts of current sized fuel and air space as you build/feed your fire,
- heat too far from a fuel or too small to ignite the next size fuel will starve your fire,
- gently and strategically place your fuels on the burning fire so you carefully tend it,
- smoke is incomplete burning and indicates you are smothering or starving your fire,
- a balanced wood fire, equal amounts of Heat, Oxygen and Fuel, gives off almost no smoke,
- 7P's – Principles, Preparation, Preparation, Preparation, Practice, Practice, Practice!
