If you accept the challenge, your patrol will be transported to a scene similar to Dyea in Alaska for a trip along the Chilkoot trail. During the Gold Rush, more than 22,000 people followed this trail through to Lake Bennett in Canada, then travelled by boat down the Yukon River to Dawson City. On the trail, test your grit, your mettle and your skills along the way.

Book your space at the trailhead by visiting [Baden-Powell Council \(scoutingevent.com\)](https://scoutingevent.com). Cost for the event will be \$6 per youth. Adults are free, but patches are available at \$2.50 each (sign up on the Black Pug registration). Adult volunteers\* will receive a free patch for their help.

Patrols, you will need a sled with:

- Ten essentials per pair of Scouts
- Pencils
- Paper
- Ropes for lashings
- Length or 2 of 100 ft rope (may be borrowed if necessary)
- Neckerchief each or other blindfold material
- Pan
- Fire-building materials for a 15-minute fire. Natural materials only, no waxes or oils
- Utensils
- Maybe other things as specified by mid-January!
