

BARTON 100 CAMPOREE

PROPOSED CAMPOREE EVENTS:

Sam Bogan Patrol Participation Event

- (1) Spend at least one night at camporee
- (2) All members hike (if medically possible) the camporee trail
- (3) Have and carry a patrol flag for your patrol

Colonel Frank Barton Patrol Hiking Event

- (1) Carry a Scout stove and a daypack with appropriate materials for the hike
- (2) Hike both the north and south rim trails
- (3) Hike the gorge trail

E. Laurence Palmer Fire Building Event

- (1) Complete the required event, achieving at least a minimum passing score.
- (2) Observe proper safety policies and procedures while cooking at the camporee

Dr. H.B. Britton/Martin "Doc" Tinker First Aid Event

- (1) Carry a first aid kit prepared by the patrol. Have it inspected and approved.
(Includes 1 neckerchief per member)
- (2) Perform appropriate and timely first aid at the assigned stations.

Charles Newman Pioneering Event

- (1) Using scout staves and ropes provided, construct the assigned task
- (2) Have each member of the patrol demonstrate at least one of the required knots

Dr. Chet Bradley Botany/Forestry Event

- (1) Maintain a list of trees and plants observed. Note locations, condition issues if any.
- (2) Report the location of poisonous plants to camporee HQ.

Louis A. Fuertes Bird Study Event

- (1) Maintain a list of birds observed. Note location, behavior, species ID if possible
- (2) Observe the peregrine falcon nest in situ

E. E. "Dusty" Bredbenner Athletics Event

Requirements:

- (1) Participate as a patrol in the designated event, achieving at least a minimum passing score.

Jim McCabe Cooking Event

- (1) Prepare and carry a trail meal for use as lunch Saturday.
- (2) Prepare a menu, purchase the food, and prepare other camporee meals to unit leader's satisfaction.
- (3) Complete the designated event, achieving at least a minimum passing score.

J Lawrence Smith History Event

- (1) Visit the camporee museum, and complete the questionnaire.
- (2) Attend the memorial program on Saturday afternoon as a patrol.

Reverend Sidney Winter A Scout is Reverent Event

- (1) Have a patrol member act as Chaplain's Aide to assist with Scout's Own Service
- (2) Participate as a patrol in the Scouts Own,
or
- (3) Meet the religious obligations of the patrols membership to the approval of the unit leader

Steven Sampson Camp Spirit Award

- (1) Be a member of a patrol which earns ribbons in all other events (except where officially excused)
- (2) Be part of a patrol nominated by unit leadership or camporee leadership
- (3) Be selected by secret vote the patrol members as most deserving of recognition
